Electric Vehicle Charging Points

Codnor Parish Council has been examining the possibility of providing Electric Vehicle charging points in the two Free Car Parks, which we provide for residents and businesses in our village. To enable us to apply for funding for these, we need to demonstrate that we have carried out a consultation with residents to establish the current and future needs in the village. The Parish Council is mindful of the government's long-term view that all transport needs to move away from petrol and diesel fuel; towards more sustainable energy to lower CO2 emissions into the atmosphere.

We want to keep this consultation simple and would ask that recipients answer just 3 questions as follows: -

- 1) Do you currently have an Electric or Hybrid powered vehicle?
- 2) Are you intending to change to an Electric or Hybrid powered vehicle in the next 3 years?
- 3) Would you use the EV Charging units in the Mill Lane or Market Place Car Parks once installed?
