1. APOLOGIES

3. POLICE MATTERS

The members of the public present at the *meeting* raised a number of issues. WPC Rohde had no knowledge of the Police report regarding vandalism at the Clock building over the New Year period. Members thanked the Police for their support at the recent Parish events.
